



The 6-4-3 Foundation Scholarship Program at Marietta High School

Program Overview:

At this time, one (1) scholarship will be awarded to a Marietta High School Senior Female Athlete (HS class of 2026). The applicant should have participated in at least one sport at MHS for at least two years. The scholarship amount will be \$2,000 paid directly to the designated college, university or technical school. Please note that applying for scholarship assistance does not guarantee any successful award of money. Any incomplete applications will be disqualified.

The scholarship winner has the opportunity to renew the scholarship for an additional \$1,000 up to two times, within three years of high school graduation. This scholarship is not to be used for graduate school. If you are awarded a scholarship, The 6-4-3 Foundation will provide information regarding scholarship renewal.

The 6-4-3 Foundation Scholarship winner will be notified in April and announced at Marietta High School's awards night.
